Sir,

I write this at a time when it is rumoured that relentless efforts are on to get you transferred from this place just because you are bent on bringing in peace and tranquility to this faction-ridden and faction-oriented district. We never heard so much about any SP who was here in the past and when we have been hearing that you have arrived to put an end to the rowdi elements and their mentors we felt that good days are not far off. Unfortunately it is not to be, it seems. Anyway we are determined to do our bit to thwart all the efforts of the political buffs. People are for you and will be behind you giving you their moral support and to raise their voice against the move. We were unfortunate to lose Dr. Subramaniam as our Collector inspite of our efforts to retain him. Had he continued for a least another two years Cuddapah could have been a much better place to live in. The role politics and the politicians play has to be combated on a war footing and this can be done only when people and the police join hands to usher in a peaceful existence. It is time for the IPS cadre as a whole to take a firm stand not to play to the tune of the corrupt politicians. Can that ever happen? Can something be done to have such a cadre? If people have something to contribute to see a cadre emerging at least in the near future tell us what we can do. Also these are the ones made use for the anti-social activities. A ban on second shows may rob a few of their enjoyment but it would benefit a number of others whose tranquility is disturbed till late in the nights every day.

2. The present stricture on the hotels to close down by 10 pm may be continued for another few years or even for ever. So also the other shops. In spite of the police order one could see many hotels and shops closing very relentlessly half an hour late and that too when there is a whistle probably from the police on beat. A strict watch may be maintained on these hotels and shops.

All the above need monitoring from higher authorities in police at regular periods and thus the links between the public and the police could be strengthened and trust and confidence could build up between the two and order can be brought into the land.

Sir the inevitable could be just round the corner and we the people never know what the politician resorts to and when. They may assure the people many things but nobody knows what happens to those assurances and so what I request you is to hasten your moves and reshape this 'bloody' district into a pleasant one.

- 13) Medicine worth of Rs. 50/- to Rs. 70/-
- 14) One tonic Bottle;
- 15) Medical Check-up by the Doctors.

After having personally visited the above panic flood affected areas on 29-10-1996, I am now prone to say that the Police authority is hardly under an aura of benevolence bequeathed by bureaucracy that shall undermine the Rule of Law; but the police has a humane-heart to help; and I pray - "So be it".
